

Faculty Development Center Call for One-Time Track Grants Program

Deadline Monday April 6, 2009 at 5:00 pm

The Faculty Development Center has one-time funding to support full-time, tenure-track and tenured faculty activity in two faculty categories

Eligible faculty are:

- Track 1: Tenure-track faculty, Year 2 through tenure (Year 1 faculty are not eligible)
- Track 2: Tenured faculty

Four grant programs are available:

Accessible Technology Initiative (ATI) Grants

Assist faculty in revising, revamping or converting an existing course to meet the instructional materials component of the CSU Accessible Technology Initiative (ATI) mandate and Universal Design for Learning (UDL) aspirations

Interdisciplinary Collaboration Grants

Assist faculty in conducting scholarly and creative activity in collaboration with other CSUF faculty across departments and/or programs

Domestic Travel Grants

Support faculty domestic travel to professional meetings, conferences, exhibits, or performances directly relevant to the faculty member's scholarship or professional development

Publication Charges Grants

Assist faculty with publication expenses such as the cost of preprints, illustrations, online publications, etc.

All applications must be e-mailed and the subject line must conform to the requirements for that grant.
